3 citizens of Amarillo in mourning the tragic loss of Stanley Allen
4 Wiley, who died January 29, 2003, at the age of 38; and

5 WHEREAS, Stanley Wiley was born in Amarillo on March 9, 1964;
6 he graduated from Tascosa High School in 1982 and attended Amarillo
7 College for two years; and

8 WHEREAS, Known as a hardworking man throughout his life,
9 Stanley was employed at a number of local businesses, and for a
10 while, he operated his own sales and publishing company; and

11 WHEREAS, In 1994, Stanley took a position as a corrections
12 officer with the Texas Department of Criminal Justice; he was
13 promoted twice and had most recently worked as a supervisor of the
14 boot shop at the Clements Unit in Amarillo; and

15 WHEREAS, Stanley took pride in his work and believed in
16 treating the inmates fairly; he had earned the respect of his
17 colleagues who remember him fondly as a man who always had something
18 good to say; and

19 WHEREAS, Stanley was a caring and attentive son, and he took
20 time to check on his grandmother on a daily basis; he was also a
21 loving uncle to his three nieces and two nephews; and

22 WHEREAS, An exemplary gentleman, Stanley leaves behind
23 memories that will be treasured forever by his family and many
24 friends; now, therefore, be it

2 hereby extend sincere condolences to the bereaved family of Stanley
3 Allen Wiley: his father, Herman Wiley; his sisters, Margaret
