

1 AN ACT
2 relating to the service area of the Blinn College District.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 130.168, Education Code, is amended to
5 read as follows:

6 Sec. 130.168. BLINN JUNIOR [~~COUNTY~~] COLLEGE DISTRICT
7 SERVICE AREA. The service area of the Blinn College District
8 includes the territory within:

9 (1) Washington, Burleson, Brazos, Madison, Grimes,
10 Waller, Lee, and Fayette counties;

11 (2) the Mumford, Hearne, and Franklin independent
12 school districts located in Robertson County;

13 (3) [~~the Bellville Independent School District~~
14 ~~located in~~] Austin County, other than the territory within the
15 Wallis-Orchard Independent School District;

16 (4) the Milano and Gause independent school districts
17 located in Milam County;

18 (5) the part of the Richards Independent School
19 District that is located in Walker and Montgomery counties; and

20 (6) the part of the Bryan Independent School District
21 that is located in Robertson County.

22 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies
23 beginning with the 2005 fall semester.

24 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
4 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
