



1           (d) This section does not affect the authority of the  
2 commission to investigate or take enforcement action against an  
3 unauthorized discharge under Section 26.121.

4           SECTION 5. Subsection (e), Section 201.026, Agriculture  
5 Code, as added by Section 1, Chapter 1189, Acts of the 77th  
6 Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, is amended to read as follows:

7           (e) At the request of the landowner, the state board may  
8 develop and certify a water quality management plan for any  
9 agricultural or silvicultural land in the state. Section  
10 26.302(b-1), Water Code, applies to a water quality management plan  
11 developed or certified for use by a poultry facility under this  
12 section.

13           SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
