

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The city of Spur has been selected as an official
2 Texas Main Street City by the Texas Historical Commission, becoming
3 one of just five communities to receive this designation for 2007;
4 and

5 WHEREAS, Sponsored by the Community Heritage Development
6 Division of the THC and affiliated with the National Trust for
7 Historic Preservation, the Texas Main Street Program assists
8 communities in revitalizing their historic downtowns and
9 neighborhood commercial districts; Spur was selected for the
10 program after submitting an application that detailed its vintage
11 architecture and commitment to preserving and promoting its core
12 business district; and

13 WHEREAS, As part of the program, officials from the
14 historical commission will perform an extensive evaluation of
15 Spur's business district and offer recommendations on how best to
16 preserve the city's historic resources and utilize them to
17 encourage economic development and tourism; in addition,
18 coordinating staff and members of the city's Main Street board will
19 receive special training from the commission, and the city will
20 have the honor of hosting Texas First Lady Anita Perry when she
21 tours the 2007 Texas Main Street communities; and

22 WHEREAS, The preservation of historic buildings not only
23 maintains a town's heritage but also provides a memorable
24 attraction that can contribute to future development; Spur's

1 participation in the Texas Main Street Program will further both of
2 these worthy goals, and this achievement reflects the exceptional
3 leadership and vision of the city's residents and civic leaders;
4 now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That the 80th Legislature of the State of Texas
6 hereby congratulate the city of Spur on its designation as a 2007
7 official Texas Main Street City and commend all those involved in
8 this project for their vital efforts to better their community;
9 and, be it further

10 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
11 prepared for the city of Spur as an expression of high regard from
12 the Texas House of Representatives and Senate.
