

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Kelly Maben of Spur set a new arena record for barrel
2 racing at the 2006 Wrangler National Finals Rodeo (NFR) held
3 November 30 - December 9 at the Thomas & Mack Center in Las Vegas,
4 Nevada; and

5 WHEREAS, Riding her 13-year-old gelding named Bubba, this
6 Spur Elementary School teacher clocked the record time of :13:58 in
7 the sixth round of the competition; ultimately winning five of the
8 10 rounds at the NFR, Ms. Maben garnered earnings totaling more than
9 \$102,000 and finished ranked third in the world; and

10 WHEREAS, Kelly Maben's success at the National Finals Rodeo
11 comes on the heels of an outstanding season for her that included
12 eight professional rodeo wins; demonstrating the talent and
13 commitment to excellence required of a world-class competitor, she
14 is indeed a source of tremendous pride to her family, friends, and
15 supporters in the community; now, therefore, be it
