1 (4) developing and providing educational tools and
2 activities designed to reduce or lead to the reduction of the
3 discharge of pollutants into stormwater; and

4 (5) assessing reasonable charges to fund the
5 implementation, administration, and operation of the stormwater
6 permitting program as necessary to comply with federal or state
7 program requirements.

8 (b) Notwithstanding Subsection (a)(5), a county, district,
9 or authority may not assess a charge against property that is:

- 10 (1) exempt from ad valorem taxation; or
11 (2) subject to an assessment for the same purpose by
12 another entity.

13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
