5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 285.001, Transportation Code, is amended
7 to read as follows:

8 Sec. 285.001. REGULATION OF ROADSIDE VENDOR AND SOLICITOR.
9 To promote the public safety, the commissioners court of a county
10 with a population of more than 1.3 [~~2.2~~] million by order may
11 regulate the following in the unincorporated area of the county if
12 they occur on a public highway or road, [~~in the unincorporated area~~
13 ~~of the county or~~] in the right-of-way of a public [~~the~~] highway or
14 road, or in a parking lot:

15 (1) the sale of items by a vendor of food or
16 merchandise, including live animals;

17 (2) the erection, maintenance, or placement of a
18 structure by a vendor of food or merchandise, including live
19 animals; and

20 (3) the solicitation of money.

21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
